If this is the first Winsham e-Letter that you have received, you may be interested in how it has come about. Briefly, it is part of the Winsham Information Loop, which is an attempt to make the various methods of communication that we have in Winsham more effective. Sponsored by the Winsham Web Museum it has the purpose of giving subscribers a very brief note of coming events in the community and referring them, if they are interested, to where they can obtain more information. It is complimentary to the Notice Boards in the Shop and other locations, the Joint Parish Magazine, Parish Web site and the various posters and 'flyers' that form the basis of parish communications – it is not a replacement. It will sometimes contain news of a more general nature, not linked to a specific organisation. For example the time and date of a funeral of somebody who lived in the parish, or to give notice of impending road works.

Although we attempt to cover as many events as possible, we cannot guarantee to include everything that is going on. If you would like to see an event covered, please send us an e-mail giving details by clicking on the link above.

The idea is that you receive the e-letter, read it, note what interests you and then dump it or hold it for a short while. Generally no more than one e-letter will be sent in a week, unless something of urgent general interest arises. More information will be posted, from time to time on the Notice Board of the Parish Web site.
