063 MATTERS ARISING FROM THESE MINUTES NOT COVERED ELSEWHERE AND ANY SUBSEQUENT ACTION TAKEN/TO BE TAKEN.

a) SPORTS AND SOCIAL CLUB - REQUEST FOR NEW LEASE - The Charity Trustees to issue a new lease to the Sports and Social Club, this did not concern the Parish Council. The Chairman to inform the Sports and Social Club accordingly. Agreed by all present.

- b) PARISH COUNCIL NOTICE BOARD The Chairman had approached the company regarding a second notice board. These were hoped to be in situ by January 1st. It was agreed that the existing notice board could not last much longer and this needed to be sorted.
- c) PARISH LEAFLET Draft copies of the Parish Leaflet had been circulated to Councillors, Mrs. S. Abbey and the Clerk. These were approved. Mr. Sullivan to order 400 copies at a cost in the region of £200.00. These should be ready to distribute before Christmas. Details from the Parish Leaflet was now on the South Somerset District Council Website. The Chairman thanked Mr. Sullivan for all the work he had carried out on this.
- d) SECURITY CABINS AT DAVIES CLOSE These now been removed and skips were being used whilst work was being carried out at Davies Close.
- e) WOODEN BIER IN CHARD MUSEUM The museum at Chard felt this was taking up too much room and were hoping the parish could house it somewhere else. Mr. Roper at Forde Abbey had been approached, and would be happy to install it in the new shop that will be opening in 1999. It would be used as a display stand for items on sale. The Council were not entirely happy with this situation, the Clerk to write to Mr. Roper to say it was to be discussed more fully at the January Council meeting. The Clerk to write to Warners at Cricket St. Thomas to enquire whether they were interested in displaying this at their new holiday complex. The Chairman to let the Clerk to have the contact name.

County Councillor's Report - Winsham Parish Council

- 1. I am sorry that I shall be unable to attend the meeting on Wednesday 2 December. I am leading a secondary school inspection in Wembley all week.
- 2. I am Chairman of the Crewkerne Town Study. The Parish Council will be aware of the government initiative to ask local authorities to undertake detailed studies of future public and road transport requirements. Somerset has a series of "corridor" and "town" studies which cover public and private transport, environmental and employment issues. It is intended that parish councils should be fully involved and put their viewpoints forward on a wide range of matters which include current problems with road maintenance, signing and provision of public transport.
- 2. The meeting of the Somerset County Council on 25 November considered many issues. Some main ones included: the need to get a fairer formula for funding of rural counties such as Somerset (a perennial) and the report of a Commission on Youth Disaffection and Community Safety. This report was agreed and the County Council are now bidding for various sources of funding available for combatting problems which include drugs and vandalism.
- 3. On my return from London next week I shall contact the Clerk to see if there are any matters that need to be pursued.
